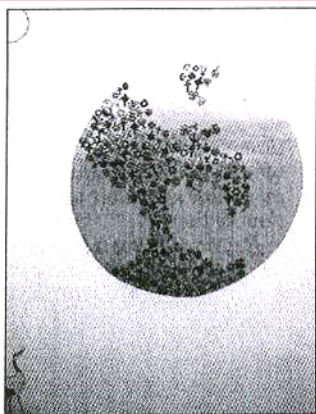
GO LOOKING FOR HANUMAN
